

Protect Your Patients From Both COVID-19 and the Flu

Any dose of the COVID-19 vaccines — whether part of a primary series or a booster — can be administered at the same time as other vaccines, including the flu vaccine.

Who Can Get Both Vaccines

Everyone ages 5 and older is eligible for both a COVID-19 vaccine and a flu vaccine.

Offer eligible patients both vaccines at the same visit, especially if they may not return for additional vaccinations.



How to Give Both Vaccines at Once



When administering multiple vaccines in a single visit, administer each shot in a different injection site.

For adults and adolescents, you can use the deltoid muscle (upper arm and shoulder) for more than one intramuscular injection. Just be sure to administer each shot at least 1 inch apart on the deltoid muscle.
